Gregory Christopher “Papadakis” Post is a composer, and classical pianist born and raised in Brooklyn, New York, with roots stemming from Imbros and Crete.

Gregory obtained his Bachelors in Piano Performance, from Brooklyn College. He has played many solo recitals and chamber music events, which include a solo recital on the island Imbros, high up in the mountains in the small village of Glyki; a solo recital performance in the celebration of the bicentennial of Chopin, in New York Winter Gardens financial center; many concerts in the park for the past four years organized by the Sing for Hope foundation, and many other recitals across the New York City area.

Along with playing solo recitals Gregory has collaborated with many different musicians, in chamber music concerts, and duets. One of the most distinguished musicians is Dr. Edward Polidi, virtuoso violinist, who has played worldwide. Gregory, and Dr. Polidi have played in multiple concert venues, in New York, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, and North Carolina, where they played the works of Beethoven, Mozart, Paganini, Brahms, and many others. He also performs frequently accompanying actress, and soprano Anna Tsoukala, performing various musical genre from Greece, and a large operatic repertoire.
